Photo I.D. is not required to vote.

A voter may register at the polling place on election day, however, a proof of residence is required. An acceptable form of Proof of Residence includes, but is not limited to the following: a current and valid WI Driver's License, a current and valid Wisconsin Identification card, any official ID card or license issued by a Wisconsin governmental body, an I.D. card with your photo issued by an employer (not including a business card), a real estate tax bill or receipt for the current year, a residential lease effective during the period that includes election day, utility bill for period starting no earlier than 90 days before election day, a bank statement, paycheck, a government check, any other official document issued by a unit of government. Please contact Jackie Mitchell if you have questions about proof of residence.

The deadline for making application to vote absentee by mail is 5:00p.m. the Thursday preceding the election. For the April 7, 2015 Spring Election the deadline is Thursday, April 2, 2015.

The first day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is the third Monday (March 23rd) before the election. The deadline for voting an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is 7:00p.m. (Friday, April 3, 2015) the Friday preceding the election.

In-person Absentee Voting may only take place between the hours of 8:00a.m. and 7:00p.m. Monday through Friday. According to 2013 Wisconsin Act 146 no weekend voting is allowed. You may contact Jackie at 715-246-5514 or e-mail [tep@sunnylink.com](mailto:tep@sunnylink.com).
