Notice of Adoption of an Ordinance

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 61.34, the Town of Erin Prairie, St. Croix County, Wisconsin, hereby publishes notice that at its Special Board Meeting held on October 30, 2025, the Town Board adopted an Ordinance – Renewable Energy Ordinance

Title: Renewable Energy Ordinance

Ordinance Number: 19-2025

Date of Enactment: October 30, 2025.

Summary: The purpose of this Ordinance is to adopt and incorporate requirements of Section 66.0401 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and to establish Town regulations for the installation, construction, operation, and use of all Solar Energy Systems in the Town of Erin Prairie, St. Croix County, Wisconsin. This Ordinance is also intended to preserve and protect the public health and safety, to not significantly increase the cost of the solar energy system or significantly decrease its efficiency, and to allow for an alternative system of comparable cost and energy.
